Ward Boundary Review Open House

Severn is <u>reviewing its ward boundaries</u> to ensure it continues to be an effective and equitable system of represe ntation that keeps pace with population growth.

It's been eight years since the last review of our ward boundaries. In 2016, the Township's five ward boundaries were re-drawn to reflect the growth of the community since 1994. Since that last review, Severn has continued to grow and change, and this project will determine if it is necessary to adjust the ward boundaries to achieve a more balanced distribution of population among wards. This helps to ensure that each councillor represents a si milar number of constituents, promoting equitable representation and responsiveness to community needs.

Guiding principles for the review include:

- balancing present and future population distribution among the wards
- respecting established neighborhoods and communities
- respecting geographic features and defining natural and infrastructure boundaries.
